### Update 81: Indonesia - COVID-19 Infections - COVID-19 Travel Restrictions Imposed on 14 Countries Amid Surge in Cases

1/08/2022, 9:32:06 AM

- Indonesian government has temporarily closed the entry of foreign nationals from 14 countries to prevent the spread of the Omicron variant
- The temporary ban took effect on January 7, 2022
- The ban applies to arrivals from countries or territories with the following criteria:
  - Countries that have confirmed community transmission of the Omicron variant: South Africa, Botswana, Norway, and France
  - Countries or territories that are geographically close to countries with community transmission of the Omicron variant: Angola, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Malawi, Mozambique, Namibia, Eswatini, and Lesotho
  - Countries or territories with over 10,000 confirmed Omicron cases: United Kingdom and Denmark
- All overseas travelers, Indonesian citizens, and foreign nationals are required to comply with the health protocols set by the government and show a COVID-19 vaccination card or certificate
- Travelers from abroad are required to get a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test and undergo quarantine at a centralized facility for a week
- Citizens coming from countries, with cases of Omicron transmission, are required to undergo quarantine at a centralized facility for 10 days

  3. Recoveries: 4,115,572 (96.49%)
  4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 284,934,477
  5. Fully Vaccinated: 116,114,884 (43.5%)

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
