Update 16: Serbia - COVID-19 Infections - Highest Daily Cases Reported

1/12/2022, 10:56:25 AM

- On January 11, 2022, Serbia reported 13,693 new cases and 22 deaths
- The country reported record numbers of new COVID-19 cases, amid the spread of 'Omicron' variant
- All travelers arriving from countries of special risk will be subjected to a 14-day home quarantine
- Mandatory testing within first 24 hours from entry and on the 7th day from the start of the measures are required
- Testing will be done by the Institute of Public Health at the expense of the person being tested
- If no symptoms appear within those 14 days, quarantine measures end without a need for additional testing
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Serbia:
 1. Confirmed Cases: 1,373,237
 2. Deaths: 12,958 (0.94%)
 3. Recoveries: 1,275,459 (92.88%)
 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 8,296,523
 5. People Fully Vaccinated: 3,222,809 (46.3%)

Impact level Definitions

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
