Update 135: Philippines - COVID-19 Alert Level 3 Imposed in 28 Additional Areas

1/13/2022, 9:48:52 AM

- These areas include 16 provinces in Luzon, seven areas in Visayas, and five areas in Mindanao
- Rule will be effective starting January 14, 2022, until January 31, 2022
- Businesses are allowed to operate at 30% indoor capacity and 50% outdoor capacity in areas under Alert Level 3
- Face-to-face classes in basic education, contact sports, fun fairs, karaoke bars, clubs, concert halls, theaters, and casinos will be prohibited
- The Department of Health (DOH) has updated its guidelines on quarantine and isolation periods for vaccinated, partially vaccinated, and unvaccinated persons
- Quarantine period for a vaccinated close-contact of a COVID-19 afflicted person will be shortened from seven days to five days
- Quarantine period will remain 14 days for partially vaccinated or unvaccinated person
- Philippines government has banned unvaccinated persons from public transport
- Philippines reported 32,246 COVID-19 cases and 144 deaths on January 12, 2022
- Luzon is the country's most populous island with a major presence of lumbering and mining industries
- Travel and tourism, IT-BPM, manufacturing, and construction are the top growth drivers in Visayas
- Agriculture, forestry, and fishing are the major industries in Mindanao

High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
