## Update 32: Greece - COVID-19 Restrictions Extended Until January 24, 2022

1/13/2022, 9:58:09 AM

- Bars, nightclubs, and restaurants will be closed at midnight
- Use of double masks remains mandatory in supermarkets and transport
- Rules which were set to expire on January 17, 2022, have now been extended until January 24, 2022
- Omicron variant is majorly responsible for the surge in cases
- New COVID-19 restrictions have been imposed on ferry travel
- Unvaccinated people must produce a negative polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test result within 72 hours of their trip
- Travelers can also produce a negative rapid test within 48 hours of their trip in order to board the ferry
- A document certifying recovery from COVID-19 within the past 90 days will also be accepted
- Greece reported 24,245 COVID-19 cases and 78 deaths on January 12, 2022
- **Reported COVID-19 stats for Greece:**
  1. Confirmed Cases: 1,592,460
  2. Deaths: 21,637 (1.36%)
  3. Recoveries: 1,189,294 (74.68%)
  4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 18,009,619
  5. Fully Vaccinated: 7,123,148 (66.4%)

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
