Update 54: Bogota, Colombia - New COVID-19 Wave Reported Amid Surge in 'Omicron' Variant

1/14/2022, 7:39:49 AM

- The maximum point of contagion due to 'Omicron' was expected in February 2022, with ~ 140,000 cases
- However, Bogota is already immersed in the fourth peak due to the high number of infections
- The city reported 43,000 COVID-19 infected patients, compared to 600 in the first week of December 2021
- Bogota citizens are advised to take care at home and finish the vaccination processes, including reinforcements
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Columbia:
 1. Confirmed Cases: 5,440,981
 2. Deaths: 130,625 (2.40%)
 3. Recoveries: 5,123,725 (94.17%)
 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 66,935,960
 5. Fully Vaccinated Population: 29,407,178 (59.5%)

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
