Update 14: Chile - COVID-19 Infections - Highest Daily Cases Reported

1/14/2022, 11:27:05 AM

- Chile registered more than 7,000 COVID-19 cases in 24 hours, after detecting 7,291 infections in one day, the highest figure in seven months
- On January 13, 2022, 41 more patients died of causes related to the disease, bringing the pandemic death toll to 39,331
- The COVID-19 positivity rate for January 12, 2022, was 6.9% nationwide and 7.39% in the Santiago Metropolitan Region
- However, Chile's 16 regions had a positivity rate below 2%
- Chile averaged 2,500 daily COVID-19 infections in December 2021, but the spread of the Omicron variant in January has pushed the average to 5,000 cases per day
- Meanwhile, Chile began applying a second booster dose of the vaccine against COVID-19 in January
- The Country is aiming to increase the population's protection against Omicron amid the tourism summer season in the Southern Hemisphere
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Chile:
 - Confirmed Cases: 1,849,465
 - Deaths: 39,331 (2.1%)
 - Recoveries: 1,771,647 (95.8%)
 - Vaccine Doses Administered: 45,325,617
 - Fully Vaccinated: 16,691,856 (87.4%)

Impact level Definitions

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
