## Update 39: Netherlands - Reclassifies South Africa as Very High-Risk Zone

1/19/2022, 9:57:30 AM

- South African citizens who have completed the immunization process against the COVID-19 will no longer be banned from entering the country
- Travelers are still required to present a negative COVID-19 test upon arrival in Netherlands
- All visitors over the age of 12 are required to follow mandatory quarantine of ten days and sign a quarantine declaration
- A negative COVID-19 PCR test result, not older than 48 hours before departure, as well as a negative antibody test not older than 24 hours, is required of all passengers over the age of 12
- The quarantine will not be required for passengers in transit
- Netherlands will accept only documents that indicate that the holder has taken the last vaccination dose within nine months
- Government is also planning to shorten the validity of vaccination certificates starting next month

  3. Recoveries: 1,993,056 (54.71%)
  4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 31,970,282
  5. Fully Vaccinated Population: 12,282,320 (70.4%)

# Impact level Definitions

Impact Level	Definitions
Immediate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
