Update 17: Czech Republic - COVID-19 Vaccine Mandate for People Aged Over 60 Dismissed Amid Rise in Infections

- People aged over 60 and some professions to get vaccinated against COVID-19 was dismissed by new government of the Czech Republic
- In early December 2020, mandatory vaccination was announced by previous government
- However, daily tally of new COVID-19 cases hit a record high
- New COVID-19 cases of 28,469 were reported on January 18, 2022, a record daily number since the start of pandemic
- Despite the record numbers, number of COVID-19 patients in hospitals dropped to 1,635 on January 18, 2022, with 252 needing intensive care
- The country's government has also shortened quarantine and isolation period
- While launching mandatory testing of employees at companies from this week
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Czech Republic:
 1. Confirmed Cases: 2,678,767
 2. Deaths: 36,972 (1.38%)
 3. Recoveries: 2,447,642 (91.37%)
 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 16,599,329
 5. Fully Vaccinated population: 6,739,854 (63%)

Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Immediate	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Info	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
