### Update 44: Hungary - COVID-19 Infections - Highest Daily Cases Reported

1/21/2022, 10:33:20 AM

- Hungarian authorities diagnosed 15,526 people with COVID-19 on January 19, 2022
- This is a new record since the outbreak in the spring of 2020
- 71 people died of COVID-19 related diseases and the number of hospitalized patients has also increased
- Citizens of Hungary are permitted to enter their territory without entry permission or polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test result
- Ten-day mandatory quarantine rule or two negative PCR tests results should be followed
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Hungary:
  1. Confirmed Cases: 1,385,500
  2. Deaths: 40,757 (2.94%)
  3. Recoveries: 1,186,319 (85.62%)
  4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 15,832,155
  5. Fully Vaccinated Population: 6,069,677 (62.1%)

## Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Immediate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Info	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
