Update 23: Argentina - COVID-19 and Influenza's Double Infection - First Case Reported

1/22/2022, 9:43:22 AM

- Argentina confirmed first case of flurona, a double infection with both COVID-19 and influenza
- A 3-year old boy was hospitalized at the Orlando Alassia Children's Hospital in Santa Fe, Argentina's eastern province
- Globally, the first cases of flurona were detected in Israel
- Regionally, Brazil was the first place to spot the portmanteau disease
- Also, on January 21, 2022, Argentina reported 118,171 new COVID-19 cases and 160 deaths
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Argentina:
 1. Confirmed Cases: 7,694,506
 2. Deaths: 118,969 (1.55%)
 3. Recoveries: 6,626,239 (86.12%)
 4. Vaccine Doses Administered 84,219,672
 5. Fully Vaccinated: 34,127,363 (75.9%)

Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Immediate	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Info	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
