Update 39: Japan - COVID-19 Restrictions Extended Amid 'Omicron' Variant Surge

- Japan plans to expand COVID-19 quasi-state of emergency to over 30 of 47 prefectures including the capital of Tokyo
- Authorities shortened restaurant opening hours to curb the surge in COVID-19 cases
- Restrictions on restaurants and bars will be in more areas including Tokyo and 15 prefectures
- A full state of emergency might involve closures of venues serving alcohol, attendance restrictions at sporting and cultural events, and fines for non-compliant businesses
- The northern island Hokkaido and the western prefecture of Osaka are among those asking for the curbs
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Japan:
 1. Confirmed Cases: 2,216,829
 2. Deaths: 18,523 (0.08%)
 3. Recoveries: 1,838,915 (82.95%)
 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 203,642,290
 5. Fully Vaccinated Population: 99,668,206 (79.1%)

Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Immediate	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Info	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
