Update 18: Peru - COVID-19 Entry Requirements Tightened

- Peruvian nationals, foreign residents and non-residents who are 12 years of age or older must show the vaccination proof at least 14 days before departure
- Travelers who are not fully vaccinated must have proof of a negative PCR test taken within 48 hours of departure to enter Peru
- Peruvian citizens and foreign residents with travel history in Botswana or South Africa within 14 days of intended arrival must have proof that they are fully vaccinated, and a negative PCR test taken within 48 hours of departure
- Non-resident foreigners with travel history from Botswana or South Africa within 14 days of intended arrival are not allowed to enter the country until at least January 30, 2022
- All passengers traveling to Peru must complete a health affidavit before arrival
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Peru:
 1. Confirmed Cases: 2,976,260
 2. Deaths: 204,404 (6.8%)
 3. Vaccine Doses Administered: 54,469,184
 4. Fully Vaccinated: 22,576,953 (70.3%)

Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Immediate	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Info	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
