Update 110: Brazil - Rise in Measles Cases Further Adds to Ongoing COVID-19 Challenges

- A new case of measles registered in Sao Paulo
- It was the third record of indigenous transmission since February 2022
- The case was confirmed this week in Santos
- Earlier, the city also identified another patient who had been diagnosed with the disease last month 2022
- In February 2022, another person with measles was identified in the city of Sao Paulo
- The government of Sao Paulo is preparing a campaign to encourage the vaccination of children up to 5 years
- Along with this, the country is also facing COVID-19 challenges

 2. Deaths: 661,710 (2.19%)
 3. Recoveries: 29,167,518 (96.54%)

Actions to Consider

- Determine if all management teams in impacted areas are current on all government-designated guidelines and restrictions and are aware of possible misdiagnosis due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and measles outbreak concurrently
- Determine if third parties or captive units have in-house health professionals to detect sickness and quarantine suspected disease carriers spotted within the business premises, if any
- Third parties or captive units are advised to educate employees and conduct workshops to help increase awareness about the diseases and their preventive measures
- Advised to be aware of the compounding health risks and the consequent impact on businesses due to increasing cases of COVID-19 and measles

Impact Level	Definition
Critical	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
