Update 4: Foxconn Technology CZ s.r.o. - Parent Company Foxconn Technology Suspends Production - Kunshan, China

4/25/2022, 10:09:12 AM

- Foxconn Technology halted operations after new COVID-19 cases were reported on site
- Two Foxconn plants were closed at Dianfa and Fuhong in Kunshan city, are two of four manufacturing campuses operated
- Operations at these plants have been suspended since April 20, 2022
- Zhengzhou campus is still operating normally, though lockdown was imposed near Foxconn's iPhone City campus in mid-April 2022
- Foxconn Technology Group, also known as Hon Hai Precision Industry Co., Ltd., is an electronics contract manufacturer headquartered in Tucheng, New Taipei City, Taiwan
- Supply Wisdom will continue to monitor and issue alerts for any relevant developments

GUIDANCE

Actions to Consider

- Evaluate whether ongoing processes and liaisons with Foxconn would get affected due to the planned suspensions of business by the company in the region
- Review current and planned relationships and services with key Foxconn's stakeholders and process managers if halting of business could impact businesses in any way and determine if services need to get transitioned
- Assess possible service disruptions, validate mitigation plans, and strengthen contract terms with the third party to ensure a continued level of service despite the business shutdown
- Assess the possible impact on any projects where Foxconn is an important partner
- Determine if the third party's Disaster Recovery and Business Continuity Plans are appropriately activated and

modified to address increased levels of employee absenteeism and unavailability of resources

- Pay close attention to any change in government policies and business environment amid rapid geo-political changes
- Advise the third party to set up a team with excellent Information Technology (IT) skills who are available 24*7 to guide employees working remotely to ensure no or minimal disruption to business operations
- Determine if the third party has migrated data to cloud so that data is easily accessible from anywhere without taxing business network infrastructure; few cloud providers are Amazon AWS, IBM Cloud, Microsoft Azure, etc

Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Critical	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
