Update 157: Philippines - COVID-19 'Omicron' Subvariant 'BA.2.12' - First Case Reported

4/28/2022, 9:27:17 AM

- The Department of Health (DOH) reported the first case of 'Omicron' subvariant 'BA.2.12'
- The World Health Organization has not classified Omicron BA.2.12 as a variant of concern
- The case was detected in a traveler who arrived from Finland on April 2, 2022
- The traveler did not undergo routine isolation at a quarantine facility since the traveler was fully vaccinated and arrived asymptomatic
- The Philippines reported 195 COVID-19 cases and 20 deaths on April 27, 2022
- **Reported COVID-19 stats for the Philippines :**
 1. Confirmed Cases: 3,685,029
 2. Deaths: 60,215 (1.63%)
 3. Recoveries: 3,614,238 (98.08%)
 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 150,857,283
 5. Fully Vaccinated: 67,640,431 (62.3%)
