Update 48: Singapore - COVID-19 'Omicron' Sub-Variant (BA.2.12.1) Cases Identified - Dengue Cases Continue to Surge

- Two COVID-19 cases have been confirmed to be infected with a new 'Omicron' sub-variant called 'BA.2.12.1'
- The new version was detected through active monitoring of the COVID-19 situation and genetic sequencing
- Ministry of Health of Singapore added that the two individuals self-isolated after testing positive for COVID-19
- The 'BA.2.12.1' is currently not on the World Health Organisation's list of variants of concern or interest, or variants under monitoring
- Preliminary studies show that 'BA.2' is more transmissible compared with the original 'Omicron' sub-variant 'BA.1'
- However, all the 'Omicron' sub-variants are highly contagious, but less deadly compared to 'Delta' or earlier variants
- In mid-April 2022, the 'BA.2.12.1' has been detected in more than 40 countries
- Along with this, the country is also facing challenges with Dengue cases
- Dengue cases in Singapore continue to climb with the number of cases crossing 6,000 in less than four months
- Currently, 941 cases were reported, the highest seven-day figure since the week of August 23, 2020, to August 29, 2020
- The sharp increase has occurred even before Singapore has reached the peak dengue season from June to October
- Authorities continue to detect egregious cases of premises with multiple mosquito breeding habitats
- **Reported COVID-19 stats for Singapore:**
 1. Confirmed Cases: 1,195,767
 2. Deaths: 1,334 (0.11%)
 3. Recoveries: 1,130,012 (94.50%)
 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 13,964,302
 5. Fully Vaccinated Population: 4,980,270 (87.3%)

Actions to Consider

- Singapore is a sovereign island city-state in maritime Southeast Asia. The country's economy is driven by the manufacturing sector. Key industry clusters in Singapore's manufacturing include electronics, chemicals, biomedical sciences, logistics, and transport engineering. Be prepared for possible disruptions to businesses in the region due to the reported incident
- Determine if all management teams in impacted areas are current on all government-designated guidelines and restrictions and are aware of possible misdiagnosis due to the ongoing cases of COVID-19 and Dengue
- Determine if that third parties or captive units fumigate their office premises often and regularly change stored water in tanks, coolers, and containers, if any
- Determine if third parties or captive units educate employees and conduct workshops to help increase awareness about the vector-borne diseases and its preventive measures
- Consider implementing suggested government and company-approved actions related to the current COVID-

Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Critical	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
