## Update 90: Canada - COVID-19 - Border Restrictions Extended

6/01/2022, 8:25:04 AM

- The Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) has extended border restrictions for travelers entering Canada until at least June 30, 2022
- Current COVID-19 travel restrictions include random testing, proof of vaccination verification, and fulfillment of mandatory ArriveCAN questions before entering Canada
- Travelers are also required to wear masks in airplanes and passenger trains
- Specific restrictions may vary depending on the age, citizenship, and vaccination status of the passengers
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Canada:
  1. Confirmed Cases: 3,869,190
  2. Deaths: 41,021 (1.1%)
  3. Recoveries: 3,533,193 (91.3%)
  4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 85,441,862
  5. Fully Vaccinated: 31,394,080 (82.7%)

- Canada is a country in North America and is known for its real estate, manufacturing, mining, finance & insurance, and construction sector. Be prepared for possible disruptions to businesses in the region due to the reported incident
- Determine if all management teams in impacted areas are current on all government-designated guidelines and restrictions and are aware of possible misdiagnosis due to the ongoing cases of Hepatitis
- Determine if third parties or captive units have in-house health professionals to detect sickness and quarantine suspected disease carriers spotted within the business premises if any

## Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Critical	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
