## Update 117: Sao Paulo, Brazil - COVID-19 Infections - Surge in Cases Reported

6/05/2022, 11:58:08 AM

- According to the Sao Paulo Municipal Servers Union, teachers and professionals from schools have observed an increase in the number of COVID-19 cases
- Professionals still denounce that the city hall does not have a testing and tracking policy, neither for children and adolescents nor for professionals who work in schools
- West Zone of Sao Paulo have reported drastic increase in cases in several schools of the municipal education network
- The state of Sao Paulo will begin to apply the fourth dose of the COVID-19 vaccine to people over 50 years of age and to all health professionals, effective June 06, 2022
- Earlier, the Sao Paulo government 's COVID-19 Contingency Center recommended the use of masks in closed places
- These decisions were taken to control the spread of infections further
- In May 2022, the number of hospitalizations for COVID-19 grew exponentially
- Occupation of intensive care units (ICUs) for COVID-19 in Sao Paulo exceeded 50%

  2. Deaths: 667,044 (2.14%)
  3. Recoveries: 30,063,682 (96.50%)
  4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 443,278,533

High	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
