## Update 29: Dominican Republic - COVID-19 Infections - Surge in Cases Reported

6/30/2022, 9:10:05 AM

- Dominican Republic's main industries include agriculture, cement, food processing, metal refining, mining, petroleum products, textiles, tobacco products, and tourism
- Santo Domingo is the capital and center of economic activity of the Dominican Republic. Important industries include metallurgy, petrochemicals and plastics, cement, and textiles, and food processing
- In the last 24 hours, 30 patients were admitted to Intensive Care Unit (ICU), raising bed occupancy to 5.1%
- In case of regular beds, 210 patients were registered, with an occupancy rate of 8.8%
- 1,014 new positive cases were also recorded in 7,555 samples processed
- Daily positivity stood at 22.16% for June 29, 2022, and that of the last four weeks of June 2022, at 12.43%
- 3,476,878 labor tests were processed for the virus, equivalent to 332,763 per million inhabitants as of June 29, 2022
- Provinces with highest number of infections are The National District (342), Santo Domingo (129), and Santiago (136)
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Dominican Republic:
  - Confirmed Cases: 605,784
  - Deaths: 4,383 (0.72%)
  - Recoveries: 598,698 (98.83%)
  - Vaccine Doses Administered: 15,763,479
  - Fully Vaccinated Population: 5,997,095 (57.9%)

## Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Critical	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	<b>Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months</b> - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
