Update 6: Morocco - COVID-19 Infections - Surge in Cases Reported

6/18/2022, 12:37:21 PM

- Morocco reported 1,568 new COVID-19 cases in the last 24 hours
- A total of 24,845,230 people has received the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine
- The new COVID-19 cases were recorded in the following regions:
- Casablanca-Settat (641)
- o Rabat-Salé-Kénitra (475)
- Marrakech-Safi (108)
- Fez-Meknes (132)
- Draâ-Tafilalet (46)
- o Tangier-Tétouan-Al Hoceima (84)
- Souss-Massa (53)
- Oriental (08)
- o Dakhla-Oued Eddahab (09)
- o Béni Mellal-Khénifra (07)
- Guelmim-Oued Noun (04), and
- Laâyoune-Sakia El Hamra (01)
- The number of active cases has reached 8,560, while 12 severe or critical cases have been reported in the past 24 hours, bringing the total number to 47
- Reported COVID-19 stats for Morocco:
 - 1. Confirmed Cases: 1.182.776
 - 2. Deaths: 16,085 (1.36%)
 - 3. Recoveries: 1,157,230 (97.84%)
 - 4. Vaccine Doses Administered: 54,758,259
 - 5. Fully Vaccinated: 23,424,784 (65.3%)

Impact Level Definitions

Impact Level	Definition
Critical	Anticipated disruption intensity is critical, and occurrence is imminent - Supply Wisdom recommends considering immediate review and action.
High	Anticipated disruption intensity is high and/or disruption is likely to occur within 3 months - Supply Wisdom recommends being in a heightened state of readiness to take quick action and confirm response plans/protocols.
Moderate	Anticipated disruption intensity is moderate and/or likely to occur within 3 to 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends reviewing current mitigation steps and being prepared to take proactive action if and when situation deteriorates further.
Low	Anticipated disruption intensity is low and/or may occur after 6 months - Supply Wisdom recommends taking proactive action if situation does not resolve in approved timeframe.
Informational	The event is pertinent information but does not have a current risk element associated with it.
